Pre-Medications (Opioids) to make sure your pet recovers comfortably	\checkmark	
Pre-Surgical Anti-inflammatory/Pain injection to help keep your pet pain free	\checkmark	
Antibiotic to prevent infection	\checkmark	
Each patient is intubated and on oxygen and gas anesthesia to aid in a smoother recovery	\checkmark
